REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 15, 2010

Mayor Michael C. Dahlgren called the meeting to order at 8:10 p.m. immediately following the LPA Hearing.

Present: Mayor Michael C. Dahlgren, Vice Mayor David Kintz, Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins, Councilmember Fred Furtado, Councilmember Manny Fernandez, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Keith Davis, Police Chief Robert G. Mangold, Utilities Director Steve Mazuk and City Clerk Jude M. Goudreau.

Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins made a motion to approve the minutes from the City Council Meeting on November 17, 2010. Councilmember Fred Furtado seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Based on the recommendation from the LPA Hearing, Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to continue the LPA Hearing to a time certain of 7:00 p.m. on January 19, 2011, to continue the discussion of Ordinance 416 and to propose an ordinance for first reading to establish a moratorium on this issue at a special council meeting on January 5, 2011. Vice Mayor David Kintz seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for comments from the public; there were none.

City Manager Mo Thornton gave the League of City Report and the City Manager's Report. The city attended the Annual Tri-city Barbeque in Pahokee and commented that it was a pleasant event. The Ethics Ordinance Drafting Committee will have 90 days to bring their ordinance forward. City Manager Thornton updated council on the current lawsuit with Lake Worth Utilities.

Chief Robert Mangold gave the police activity report for the month of November.

City Attorney Keith Davis had no report.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for Council comments: Councilmember Fred Furtado commended SWS for their excellent customer service. He said that staff did an excellent job putting together Monday's Golf Cart Parade. He would also like to have the council meeting times discussed at the next council meeting. Councilmember Higgins said she received a call prior to the meeting asking if we were charging a fee to the instructors who were using the park. She also asked where the city is with the tennis court resurfacing process. Councilmember Higgins read a letter that was sent to council from Rae Badt regarding SWS. She also reminded everyone about the Employee Christmas Fund. Vice Mayor Kintz thanked Mo, Steve and Chief for a job well done on the Golf Cart Parade on Monday. Councilmember Fernandez gave the financial reports and the Police Pension fund audit. Mayor Dahlgren thanked everyone for coming on Monday night. He also said he has received numerous complaints about the Lake Worth Drainage District project on the north canal. He said that the Country Club has been planting on the golf course to try to beautify the area. He wished everyone a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.
