REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2010

Mayor Michael C. Dahlgren called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Present: Mayor Michael Dahlgren, Vice Mayor David Kintz, Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins, Councilmember Fred Furtado, Councilmember Manny Fernandez, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Keith Davis, Police Chief Robert Mangold, Utilities Director Steve Mazuk and City Clerk Jude M. Cochran.

Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to approve the minutes from the City Council Meeting on October 20, 2010. Vice Mayor David Kintz seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Under Miscellaneous Business: Tony Badala and Patty Hamilton from Southern Waste Systems presented information regarding the service they provide. They answered resident's questions and concerns about the back door service they provide to the city. Rae Badt of 301 North Country Club, Ron Reeves of 224 Turnberry Drive and Craig Mitchell of 261 North Country Club Drive had their concerns addressed by Mr. Badala.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for comments from the public: Dave Taylor of 404 North Country Club Drive made a suggestion to council about hiring experts to advise them on the tennis court repairs and security cameras.

City Manager Mo Thornton gave the League of City Report. The next meeting will be in North Palm Beach where the League will appoint two members to the drafting committee for the Ethics Ordinance. She also gave the City Manager's Report and recommended to council, a workshop to discuss the tennis courts. The city manager is working with a company for replacement underground garbage cans.

Chief Robert Mangold gave the police activity report for the month of October.

City Attorney Keith Davis had no report.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for Council comments: Councilmember Higgins commented on the Halloween Party and how successful it was. She recently attended an open house at the Atlantis Country Club and said it was a great event. Vice Mayor Kintz suggested a concrete company on Lake Worth Road for replacement sleeves for the underground cans. Vice Mayor Kintz said he was encouraged by the chief's report this month. Councilmember Fernandez gave the city's financial report. Mayor Dahlgren thanked all the volunteers for their hard work to the city. Mayor Dahlgren announced that City Attorney Trela White was recently appointed to the Ethics Ordinance Drafting Committee.
