REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 19, 2011

Mayor Michael C. Dahlgren called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m

Present: Mayor Michael C. Dahlgren, Vice Mayor David Kintz, Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins, Councilmember Fred Furtado, Councilmember Manny Fernandez, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Keith Davis, Police Chief Robert G. Mangold, Utilities Director Steve Mazuk and City Clerk Jude M. Goudreau.

Councilmember Fred Furtado made a motion to approve the minutes from the LPA Hearing on December 15, 2010, City Council Meeting on December 15, 2010, LPA Hearing on January 5, 2011 and the City Council Meeting on January 5, 2011. Vice Mayor David Kintz seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

City Attorney Keith Davis read by title only on second and final reading, Ordinance 417 a Moratorium on the establishment of Pain Clinics and Pharmacies in the City of Atlantis. After a brief discussion, Councilmember Fred Furtado made a motion to approve the ordinance. Vice Mayor David Kintz seconded the motion. City Manager Thornton reported that she would like to convene a committee of interested persons to make recommendations to the city council regarding permanent regulations. Councilmember Fernandez recommended that David Kintz be the council representative on this committee. By consensus, council agreed to the committee. Motion passed 5-0.

City Attorney Keith Davis read by title only Resolution 11-01 a resolution naming the Supervisor of Elections to the Canvassing Board for Municipal Elections. Mayor Pro Tem Higgins made a motion to approve the resolution. Councilmember Manny Fernandez seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Miscellaneous Business: Mr. David Thomas from Holyfield and Thomas presented council with the City's Financial Audit. Mayor Pro Tem Higgins made a motion to approve the audit. Councilmember Fernandez seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

After a brief discussion regarding the Council Meeting time, Mayor Dahlgren asked for public comments. William Mitchell of 261 North Country Club Drive commented that he prefers the meeting time to remain the same. Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to change the City Council Meeting time from 7:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. Vice Mayor Kintz seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-2.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for comments from members of the public: Gene Davis of 446 French Royale Circle spoke on behalf of the French Royale Villa Association regarding assistance from the city to have a wall built on Lantana Road from the Shoppes of Atlantis to Pine Tree Court. Residents Chris Hansen of 383 Villa Drive South, Andy Innocenzi of 426 French Royale Circle, Joy Bayrousty of 418 French Royale Circle, Ray Hess of 442 French Royale Circle, Nino DeSilva of 422 French Royale Circle, all addressed council regarding the installation of wall along Lantana Road to abate noise and for security proposes. Ivan Goldberg commented on the recent ethics commission and the wall along Lantana Road. Council directed the Association to the Golf Club as the property belongs to them.

City Manager Mo Thornton gave the League of Cities report. She was appointed to the funding committee for the Inspector General. She briefed council on the Lake Worth Sewer lawsuit. Mrs. Thornton commended Mayor Dahlgren on an awesome job representing for the city at the joint meeting

held on January 12. City Manager Thornton asked council for direction on the upcoming Spring Fling, April 2, 2011. By consensus, the council would like to move forward with the event including the fireworks.


Chief Mangold gave the crime report for the month of December and read a letter of commendation for Officer Raja.

City Attorney Davis updated council on the Inter-Local Agreement with the NPDES Group for storm water that will be coming up in the spring of this year.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for Council comments: Councilmember Fred Furtado commented that the mayor did an excellent job speaking at the joint session meeting on January 12, 2011. He also commented on the security the police department provides to the city. He said he has been in law enforcement for 40 years and has worked with the city police and feels they do an excellent job, and there is little crime in our city. Mayor Pro Tem Higgins commented on the request brought forward by French Royale Villa Association and the noise from helicopters; she has received emails from a citizen in a surrounding community regarding a committee against the helicopter noise. Vice Mayor Kintz commented on the good job the mayor did speaking at the joint meeting and he was very proud of him. He also commented that he was very happy the security in the city and thanked the Chief Mangold for the hard work. Councilmember Manny Fernandez gave the city and utilities department financial reports. Mayor Dahlgren thanked everyone for their comments about the Joint Meeting. He commented on the security in the city. He has also received positive comments from the residents regarding the gate guards. The Mayor also congratulated Officer Raja on his letter of commendation.
