REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
MINUTES  
WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2011

Mayor Michael C. Dahlgren called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m

Present: Mayor Michael C. Dahlgren, Vice Mayor David Kintz, Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins, Councilmember Fred Furtado, Councilmember Manny Fernandez, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Keith Davis, Police Chief Robert G. Mangold, Utilities Director Steve Mazuk and City Clerk Jude M. Goudreau.

Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to approve the minutes from City Council Meeting on January 19, 2011. Vice Mayor David Kintz seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

City Attorney Keith Davis read by title only Resolution 11-02 a resolution authorizing the mayor to sign an agreement with Zambelli Fireworks. Vice Mayor Kintz made a motion to approve the resolution. Councilmember Fred Furtado seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

City Attorney Keith Davis read by title only Resolution 11-03 a resolution authorizing liens to be placed on certain properties for nonpayment of water and/or sewer charges. Mayor Pro Tem Higgins made a motion to approve the resolution. Vice Mayor Kintz seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

In Miscellaneous Business: Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to move the March Council Meeting from the 16<sup>th</sup> to the 9<sup>th</sup> due to a conflict with Spring Break. Councilmember Fred Furtado seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for public comments and there were none.

City Manager Mo Thornton gave the League of Cities report. The next meeting will be February 23, 2011 at the Riviera Beach Marina. The Inspector General Funding Sub-Committee has finished their work and made recommendation to the full committee. The city manager reminded council of the Pension Board meeting tomorrow, Thursday February 17<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am. There will be a Council Workshop on February 23, 2011 at 3:00 pm. Mrs. Thornton also informed Council that there will be a community day on March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2011 to assist an elderly widow with bringing her property up to minimum property standards. The city is not funding the project, although they are assisting. Volunteers throughout the city have come forward to assist and donate materials and labor.


Chief Mangold gave the crime report for the month of January.
