MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 5, 2011

Mayor Michael C. Dahlgren called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. immediately following the LPA Hearing.


Present: Mayor Michael C. Dahlgren, Vice Mayor David Kintz, Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins, Councilmember Fred Furtado, Councilmember Manny Fernandez, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Keith Davis, Police Chief Robert G. Mangold, and City Clerk Jude M. Goudreau

City Attorney Davis read by title only Ordinance 417 enacting a six month Moratorium on all development applications and orders relative to the development, renovation or use of any pharmacy or pain management clinic that dispenses or proposes to dispense controlled substances in the City of Atlantis

Based on the recommendation from the LPA Hearing, Councilmember Fred Furtado made a motion to approve the first reading of Ordinance 417. Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Dahlgren adjourned the meeting at 7:06 p.m. and then reconvened the meeting at 7:08 pm at the recommendation of City Manager Mo Thornton to briefly discuss provisions in the related Ordinance 416 that will set forth the regulations for pain management clinics and pharmacies. Councilmember Furtado inquired about an existing pharmacy in the Airport Plaza Center with regard to the recommended half mile requirement. Attorney Davis will check into that. City Manager Thornton requested direction regarding the re-scheduled LPA Hearing for Ordinance 416. By consensus the City Council agreed to provide their comments to the manager and asked that the LPA Hearing be postponed until such time as we have a better draft of the regulations.

The Meeting adjourned at 7:14pm.
