REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
WEDNESDAY, MAY 16, 2012
MINUTES

Mayor Michael Dahlgren called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Michael Dahlgren, Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins, Councilmember Fred Furtado, Councilmember Manny Fernandez, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Keith Davis, Police Chief Robert Mangold, Utilities Director Steve Mazuk, and City Clerk Jude M. Goudreau. Vice Mayor David Kintz was absent from the meeting.

Councilmember Fred Furtado made a motion to approve the minutes from the Council Workshop and City Council Meeting on April 18, 2012 and the Council Workshop on May 2, 2012. Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Attorney Davis read by title only Resolution 12-07- A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an agreement with the City of Greenacres for Fire Services. Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins made a motion to approve the resolution. Councilmember Manny Fernandez seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Attorney Davis read by title only Resolution 12-08- A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an agreement with Southern Waste Systems for Garbage Services. Councilmember Fred Furtado made a motion to approve the resolution. Councilmember Manny Fernandez seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Attorney Davis read by title only Resolution 12-09- A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an agreement with Jay Foy of Stormwater J for Engineering Services. Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to approve the resolution. Councilmember Fred Furtado seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Attorney Davis read by title only Resolution 12-10- A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an agreement with M &M Asphalt for Road Construction Projects. Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to approve the resolution. Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Attorney Davis read by title only Resolution 12-11- A Resolution to amend 2011-2012 Budget. Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins made a motion to approve the resolution. Councilmember Manny Fernandez seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Miscellaneous Business: There was none.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for comments from the public; Craig Mitchell 261 North Country Club inquired about the new track for the gate on JFK Drive. The city will look into the matter.

City Manager Mo Thornton gave the League of Cities Report. The city co-hosted the April luncheon at the Atlantis Country Club, there were over 170 people who attended. Mrs. Thornton said that the Country Club did a fabulous job accommodating everyone. The


League is working on a Countywide issue that will affect our city. The City may not receive the 12.50 traffic money, because our new radio system is part of MPSCC and not Motorola. The City Manager, the Mayor and the Chief all met with Commissioner Shelley Vanna to discuss the issue and she will keep Council updated. Under the City Manager's Report; the results of the Security Survey are in and she will meet with the Security Committee in the morning to discuss them. She will publish the results in the newsletter. The bids for the Congress Ave wall project all came back in too high; she will continue to work on it.

Chief Robert Mangold gave the Crime Report for the month of March.

City Attorney Keith Davis has been working on the 12.50 radio issue and reminded council of the Special Magistrate meeting next week.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for comments from Council: Councilmember Fred Furtado commented on the lakes and the annexing the property north of the city on Military Trail up to the 7-11 gas station. Councilmember Manny Fernandez gave the City and Utilities Department financial reports and said the budgets are on track so far. Mayor Dahlgren commented on the lakes looking messy.
