MINUTES

Mayor Kintz called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Present were: Mayor David Kintz, Vice Mayor Catherine Higgins, Mayor Pro Tem Aaron Rinker, Councilmember Fred Furtado, Councilmember Ralph White, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Trela White, City Clerk Kristen Puhalainen, Police Chief Robert Mangold, and Utilities Director Steve Mazuk.

Motion by Mayor Pro Tem Aaron Rinker, second by Councilmember Ralph White, to approve the minutes of the City Council meeting on July 22, 2015 and the Council Workshop on August 5, 2015. Motion carried 5-0.

Ms. White read Resolution 15-14 by title, authorizing the Mayor to sign an agreement with D.S. Eakins Construction Corp. for Lift Station 6. Mayor Kintz asked for public comments; there were none. Motion by Vice Mayor Higgins, second by Councilmember White to approve Resolution 15-14. Motion carried 5-0.

Ms. White read Resolution 15-15 by title, adopting the official zoning map. Mayor Kintz asked for public comments; there were none. Motion by Councilmember Furtado, second by Mayor Pro Tem Rinker to approve Resolution 15-15. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Kintz asked for comments from the public. There were none.

Ms. Thornton gave the League of Cities Report: She attended the Florida League of Cities Annual Conference this month. The August meeting will be next Wednesday in Royal Palm Beach.

Ms. Thornton gave the Treasurer's report: The general and utility funds are performing as expected, and the city is expected to end the year close to the budgeted amount.

Ms. Thornton gave the Manager's Report: The cost for additional milling and paving from Fairway Court to the end of S. Country Club Drive is \$60,125.00 in addition to the \$380,000.00 bid for the original project. She recommends funding the addition to complete the length of the road. The cost of the entire project would be \$440,000.00. The consensus of the Council was to find the funding for the additional roadwork.

Chief Mangold gave the crime report for July.

Ms. White gave City Attorney report: The Motion to Dismiss in the small claims case against the city will be heard tomorrow.

Mayor Kintz asked for comments from Council:

Councilmember Furtado had no comments.

Councilmember White asked about garbage collection.

Mayor Pro Tem Rinker had no comments.


