MINUTES

Mayor Kintz called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Present were: Mayor David Kintz, Vice Mayor Catherine Higgins, Mayor Pro Tem Aaron Rinker, Councilmember Michael LaCoursiere, Councilmember Lauri Melear, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Jennifer Ashton, City Clerk Kristen Puhalainen, Police Chief Robert Mangold, and Public Works Director Steve Mazuk.

Motion by Councilmember LaCoursiere, second by Mayor Pro Tem Rinker to approve the minutes of the City Council Meeting on May 18, 2016. Motion carried 5-0.

Ms. Ashton read Ordinance 440 by title: Amending Chapter 15. Zoning. Second and final reading. Mayor Kintz asked for comments from the public; there were none. Motion by Vice Mayor Rinker, second by Vice Mayor Higgins to approve Ordinance 440. Motion carried 5-0.

In Miscellaneous Business, Ms. Thornton explained the Mosquito Control Proposals from Clarke Environmental Mosquito Management Inc. There was discussion. By consensus, the Council will not take action on mosquito control.

Ms. Thornton reported that the Florida League of Cities Conference is taking place in Hollywood Florida this year, and she is attending. Council is required to appoint a voting delegate to the conference, and she requested she be appointed. Motion by Councilmember LaCoursiere, second by Vice Mayor Rinker to appoint City Manager Mo Thornton as the City's voting delegate to the Florida League of Cities conference. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Kintz asked for comments from the public. There were none.

Ms. Thornton gave the League of Cities Report: The next meeting is June 22<sup>nd</sup> at Bear Lakes Country Club.

Ms. Thornton said that the Treasurer's and Manager's Reports were covered in the Budget Workshop held earlier.

Chief Mangold gave the crime report for May.

Ms. Ashton had no report.

Mayor Kintz asked for comments from Council:

Councilmember LaCoursiere had no comments.

Councilmember Melear thanked Ms. Thornton for the new hedge on JFK Drive.

Mayor Pro Tem Rinker had no comments.

Vice Mayor Higgins praised the maintenance at the west gate, and wished Ms. Thornton an early Happy Birthday.

Mayor Kintz asked about the code issues at 261 Gleneagles Drive.
