MINUTES

Mayor David Kintz called the workshop to order at 5:06 p.m.

Present at the meeting were; Mayor David Kintz, Vice Mayor Catherine Higgins, Mayor Pro Tem Michael Dahlgren, Councilmember Manny Fernandez, Councilmember Fred Furtado, City Manager Mo Thornton, Chief Robert Mangold, Utilities Director Steve Mazuk, and City Clerk Kristen Puhalainen.

There was a lengthy discussion regarding the wall and chain-link fence options for Congress Avenue, along with funding options. City Manager Mo Thornton explained the assessment process. The Council asked for all potential perimeter capital projects to be placed on the next regular council agenda as action items.

Councilmember Furtado left the workshop at 5:34 p.m.

Other large capital projects were discussed, including road striping and landscaping the Congress Avenue islands. Ms. Thornton will get an estimate for completing the landscape plan for the islands from Urban Design Kilday Studios.

There was discussion on developing a five year plan for budget, revenue and capital improvements. The manager will work with Jay Foy of Stormwater J Engineering on formulating a road plan.

Ms. Thornton updated the Council on the security company selection process. The company Securitas will be recommended at the next regular council meeting.
