MINUTES

Mayor Kintz called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Present were: Mayor David Kintz, Vice Mayor Catherine Higgins, Mayor Pro Tem Aaron Rinker, City Manager Mo Thornton and City Clerk Kristen Puhalainen. Fred Furtado and Ralph White were absent. Tom Lanahan was also present.

Ms. Thornton introduced Steven McDonald of GAI Consultants, Inc. Mr. McDonald gave a presentation on the Stormwater Utility Rate Study and answered questions from Council.

The consensus of the Council is to proceed with the stormwater utility, to be enacted by Ordinance.

Ms. Thornton led a discussion on potential stormwater and road projects. The council asked for pricing on projects to be considered.

Ms. Thornton explained how the 2016 Presidential Preference Primary affects municipal elections with regard to the election date and qualifying period. The consensus of the Council is to change the qualifying period to start November 10 and end November 24. They would also like an amendment to the sign code to restrict erection campaign signs to 30 days prior to the election.

Ms. Thornton asked for direction with regard to potential zoning at 5800 S. Military Trail. A potential buyer of the property is proposing a daycare center. The consensus of the Council is that the use would not be a good fit for the city.

Ms. Thornton said she would like to schedule a workshop on the airport for the benefit of the new Councilmembers. The Council agreed.
