MINUTES

Mayor Kintz called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

Present were: Mayor David Kintz, Vice Mayor Catherine Higgins, Mayor Pro Tem Aaron Rinker, Councilmember Michael LaCoursiere, Councilmember Lauri Melear, City Manager Mo Thornton, Police Chief Robert Mangold, City Attorneys Trela White and Jennifer Ashton, and City Clerk Kristen Puhalainen.

Mayor Kintz asked Ms. White to present the proposed zoning code changes. She explained the changes in the draft Ordinance. Pat Burns and Dino Gavazza of JFK Hospital were present to report on its future plans and answer questions. The Council discussed the proposals and made suggestions on the Ordinance to be brought to the Local Planning Agency in May.

Ms. White explained the history and purpose of the Safe Neighborhood Improvement District. Chief Mangold reported on the Safe Neighborhood Improvement Committee's project proposals. Ms. Thornton asked the Council for direction as to the projects for inclusion in the FY 2017 budget.

Mayor Kintz opened the discussion of a baseball spring training facility and homeless resource center in John Prince Park. County officials are pursuing the Atlanta Braves to build a spring training facility in the park along 6th Avenue. County officials are also considering putting a homeless center in the park across from JFK Drive. By consensus, a Resolution in support of the spring training facility will be brought to Council at the April 20th meeting.
