**Manager's Notes, MARCH 2010**

At the last council meeting I had the privilege to meet Howard Brembeck. Many of you know Howard as a long time resident of the city. A little birdy (thank you Nancy Hogan) told me that he recently turned 100 years old. The council presented Mr. Brembeck with a proclamation in honor of his 100 years. Howard and his wife Myra purchased one of the first villas in Atlantis Villas in 1963, and nine years later built the beautiful home at 364 South Country Club Drive. That house on South Country Club Drive has always been one of my favorites! Many of the facts for the proclamation came from Mr. Brembeck's own book that was loaned to me by another special resident. What a fabulous life! We wish you 100 more Mr. Brembeck!

The special resident who loaned me the book, Andy Hornik, is retiring from the Board of Adjustment. He has served on this board since 1987. Thank you, Mr. Hornik, for your 23 years of service to the city. Dan Stedem's term on the Pension Board expires this month, and he has decided to retire as well. Dan has served as the Chairman of the Police Pension Board since 2003. During Dan's tenure he remained steadfast in his fiduciary commitment to the pension fund. We will miss his input on this board. In another sign of the times, we are seeing an increase in the number of customers that pay their utility bills after the due date. Last year the Utilities Department brought in almost \$17,000 in revenue from late fees and turn off fees. We are like any other small business that must collect the receivables in order to pay the bills. We take credit cards as another means for our customers to pay utility bills, permit fees and other items.

Click on **Online Utility Payments**,

Click on **Pay Utility Bills**. This will take you to the screen to enter your credit card information. We are notified immediately via email when payments are made from the web site.

We also continue to offer the Automated Clearing House (ACH) transfer to pay your bill. Many of you already take advantage of this service. Using this service, we will debit the bank account that you have on file with us on the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month following the bill date. This way your payment is never late. If you wish to sign up for this service, please complete the form on page 4 and return it to Jean Barbieri with a voided check. Save yourself a stamp; save a potential \$10 late charge.

Keep in mind that we must **receive** your payment by the due date. Some of our customers use the auto-payment service offered by their bank. If you do this please have your Atlantis address in your account information and be sure to schedule your payment with enough time for a check to reach us prior to the due date. The bank sends the payment by check, and we all know about delays and lost mail. Of course, we still take cash and handwritten checks! We would prefer that you spend your \$10 to purchase a wristband for the Spring Fling and come out for a day of fun!

The City of Atlantis Council Meeting was held at 7:30 pm on February 17, 2010.

Ordinance 412, Amending Chapter 2, Code Enforcement, passed 5-0 upon its second and final reading. This updates the language in the city code to be in sync with state laws. It also addresses the fine assessment criteria for repeat violations.

**Board of Adjustment Vacancy**

The retirement of Andy Hornik leaves a vacancy on the Board of Adjustment. The Board of Adjustment is charged with the responsibility to review special exceptions or variances to the zoning code for Atlantis.

Under Miscellaneous Business, Mayor Fernandez read a proclamation for Mr. Howard Brembeck of Orange Tree Drive, in celebration of his 100th birthday. Mr. Brembeck was in attendance and looked his normal dapper self. The Mayor and Council declared February 9th as a day of celebration in honor of Howard Brembeck. Congratulations Howard!

Mr. Ryan White of North Country Club Drive suggested to council that the city build a sand volleyball court at Sunset Park. Council liked the idea and will check into its feasibility.

The City Council will consider the appointments to this board at the Organizational Meeting at 7:00 pm on March 17, 2010.

**Dark House Program:** Many of our residents will soon be heading to summer homes outside of Atlantis. The police department recommends that these residents help to ensure the security of their homes by listing them with the department prior to departing Atlantis.

Once we receive the necessary information, and the home is unoccupied, police officers will perform periodic security checks of these residences. If anything is found to be amiss, the resident and /or their emergency contact will be notified so that appropriate action can be taken to correct the problem. ## No postage, No late charges, No checks to write with Automatic Bill Payment

The City of Atlantis Utilities provides customers with the convenience of Auto Pay for their Utility Bills. By providing us with your bank information, the City is able to automatically deduct your utilities payments from your account . You may sign up for this service at any time. The following should answer any questions you may have concerning this service.

**Q. How do I sign up for Auto Draft Services?**

A. Complete the authorization form and send it, or drop it off at City Hall. We are located at 260 Orange Tree Drive, Atlantis, Florida 33462.

**Q. How will my bill be paid?**

A. On the fifth of the month following the bill date, your account will be debited for the amount of your bill.

**Q. Do I have to bank with a certain bank?**

A. Your financial institution must be able to access the Federal Reserve Automated Clearing House (ACH). Most U.S. Financial institutions have access to this network. Payments must be made in US Funds.

**Q. Is there a fee for this service?**

*What you should know before you paint your house....*

The City Council recently passed ordinances about painting the exterior of our homes. This was done in order to preserve the “traditional” character of Atlantis. Key points of these new ordinances are the following:

- Exterior paint colors must be harmonious with each other and representative of the neighborhood where you live.
- Bright and brilliant colors are discouraged; fluorescent or metallic paints are prohibited.
- A permit is required to paint your house. The permit fee is \$40.
- The City’s Architectural Review Committee (ARC) will review and approve exterior color choices before the permit is issued.
- Existing house colors will not be “grandfathered” in—there are no exceptions to the need for a permit before you begin to paint.

Here’s how to apply for a permit:

1. Choose your colors, both the primary color and contrasting trim.
2. Obtain written approval from your Association, if appropriate.
3. Prepare for ARC review by submitting materials to the Permit Clerk by 4:00 PM on Friday for ARC review on the following Wednesday.

Permit application must accompany the following:

- paint chips of primary and contrasting colors (2 of each)
- a color photo of your home, including the roof and driveway. This will allow the ARC to evaluate whether the paint colors are harmonious with the rest of your home

And now you’re good to go! Remember to call City Hall for a final inspection when the work is completed.






