## **MINUTES**

Chief Mangold called the meeting to order at 5:03 p.m. Present were committee members Dan Lishansky, Flossie Napolitano, , Michael Prestera, Lou Weinstein, City Manager Mo Thornton, and City Clerk Kristen Puhalainen. Also in attendance was resident Jay Feldman. Charles Schandelmayer arrived at 6 p.m.

Chief Mangold reported on recent crime activity in the City.
