

# Safe Neighborhood Act Committee

## MINUTES

Chief Mangold called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Present were committee members Dan Lishansky, Michael Pretera, Charles Schandelmayer, Lew Weinstein, City Manager Mo Thornton and City Clerk Kristen Puhalainen. Flossie Napolitano was absent. Also in attendance was guest Bill Hancsak.

Motion by Lew Weinstein, second by Michael Pretera to approve the minutes of the May 14<sup>th</sup> meeting. Motion carried 4-0.

Chief Mangold distributed summaries of projects by location and by type. The committee discussed the projects, and by consensus agreed that the top four priorities are:

1. The fence behind the Shoppes of Atlantis
2. Additional lighting, including motion lights on Clubhouse Boulevard
3. Replacing the entrance gate on Military Trail
4. The fence on Congress Avenue north of Clubhouse Boulevard.

The committee discussed city grants for barrier plants.

The committee discussed funding for maintenance of security projects, and the purpose and process of a non-ad valorem assessment.

The June meetings will be held on the 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>.
