REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 18, 2012
MINUTES

Mayor Michael Dahlgren called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Michael Dahlgren, Vice Mayor David Kintz, Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins, Councilmember Fred Furtado, Councilmember Manny Fernandez, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Keith Davis, City Attorney Abigail Forrester Jorandby, Police Chief Robert Mangold, and City Clerk Jude M. Goudreau.

Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to approve the minutes from the Local Planning Agency, Organizational and City Council Meetings held on March 21, 2012. Vice Mayor David Kintz seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Attorney Davis read by title only Ordinance 420, an ordinance amending Chapter 9 Business Tax Receipts. Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins made a motion to approve the ordinance. Councilmember Fred Furtado seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0 on second and final reading.

Attorney Davis read by title only Ordinance 421, an ordinance amending Chapter 8 Flood Hazard Prevention. Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to approve the ordinance. Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0 on second and final reading.

Miscellaneous Business: There was a discussion regarding the replacement of park equipment. Councilmember Manny Fernandez made a motion to replace the playground equipment at Kintz Park with an amount not to exceed \$40,000. Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for comments from the public; there were none.

City Manager Mo Thornton gave the League of Cities Report. There will be an elected official's workshop on April 25, 2012 at the Atlantis Country Club. The city will be co-hosting the April League of Cities meeting at the Atlantis Country Club. Under the City Manager's Report; a big thank you to the Atlantis Country Club, all the volunteers and sponsors for making Spring Fling so successful. Approximately 500 people attended.

Chief Robert Mangold gave the Crime Report for the month of March.


City Attorney Keith Davis said he has been working on ordinances and easements and has nothing new to report to council.
