

MINUTES OF CODE ENFORCEMENT
SPECIAL MAGISTRATE HEARING
HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS
260 ORANGE TREE DRIVE
ATLANTIS, FL 33462
February 22, 2011

Special Magistrate B. Douglas Mac Gibbon presided over the hearing, which commenced at 9:30 am. In attendance were: City Attorney Abigail Jorandby, City Manager Mo Thornton, Sgt. William Amason and City Clerk Jude M. Goudreau

Case No. 11-18 Sergeant William Amason testified to the facts in the case. It is the Order of the Special Magistrate that a Fine in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) is hereby assessed at a daily amount of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per day for the violations which existed on the property beginning from February 5th, 2011 through February 6th, 2011, a period of Two (2) days. The Respondent shall be assessed Forty-Seven Dollars and Fifty-Four Cents (\$47.54) for the unpaid administrative costs incurred in prosecuting the January 25th, 2011 Violation Hearing, as well as Forty-Six Dollars and Ten Cents (\$46.10) for the administrative costs incurred in prosecuting the February 22nd, 2011 Fine Assessment Hearing.

Case No. 08-030. Barbara Allen, representative for Conrad Baker, Shoppes of Atlantis, was present. It is the Order of the City of Atlantis Special Magistrate that the request for a fine reduction is denied. In Case Number 08-030, the fine shall remain as previously assessed in the amount of Seven Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$7,300.00). Respondent shall pay said fine including the unpaid administrative costs in the amount of Sixty Dollars and Seventy Cents (\$60.70). Furthermore, in Case Number 07-12, the fine shall remain as previously assessed in the amount of One Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$1,650.00). Respondent shall pay said fine including the unpaid administrative costs in the amount of Sixty Dollars and Fifty-Six Cents (\$60.56).

The hearing adjourned at 9:50 AM
