CITY COUNCIL MEETING
TUESDAY NOVEMBER 13, 2012
MINUTES

Mayor Michael Dahlgren called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Present at the meeting: Mayor Michael Dahlgren, Vice Mayor David Kintz, Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins, Councilmember Fred Furtado, City Manager Mo Thornton, City Attorney Keith Davis, Police Chief Robert Mangold, Utilities Director Steve Mazuk and City Clerk Jude Goudreau. Councilmember Manny Fernandez was absent from the meeting.

Vice Mayor David Kintz made a motion to approve the minutes from the City Council Meeting on October 17, 2012. Mayor Pro Tem Catherine Higgins seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

Miscellaneous Business: There was none.

Mayor Dahlgren asked for comments from the public; there were none.

The City Manager gave the League of Cities report; the next League of Cities meeting is the Tri Cities Barbeque on December 7, 2012 in Pahokee. The District Two and Three lunch is tomorrow at the Atlantis Country Club. The road project is out to bid and due in early December, and if possible will be on the agenda for the December Council Meeting. We have recently completed multiple water, sewer and storm drain repairs, some of them were completed by our crews and others by contractors. The City Manager thanked everyone involved for their hard work. The auditors came today to start our annual audit. She is still working on final numbers for fiscal 2012. The proposed Lake Worth Agreement has been circulated and she has not heard of their reaction yet, but will keep council informed. Mrs. Thornton reminded everyone that the Annual Golf Cart Parade is December 10, 2012. There was a brief discussion regarding the dates in the proposed Lake Worth Agreement.


Chief Robert Mangold gave the Crime Report for the month of October.

The Mayor thanked everyone for coming, wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving and reminded everyone of the annual Golf Cart Parade on December 10, 2012.
