RESOLUTION NO. 21-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTIS, FLORIDA, APPOINTING CERTAIN OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY OF ATLANTIS CHARTER, ARTICLE III. GOVERNMENT; AT SECTION 7. THROUGH SECTION 9.; PROVIDING THAT CHECKS DRAWN UPON ANY DEPOSITORY OF CITY FUNDS MAY BE SIGNED BY ALL MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlantis Charter, Article III. Government; Section 7. Appointment of Mayor and Vice Mayor. provides for an organizational meeting of the City Council no later than the last day of March following a municipal election; and

WHEREAS, Article III of the City of Atlantis Charter provides for the appointment of other officers and employees in accordance with Sections 8. and 9. at such organizational meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlantis Charter, Article IV. City Officers. Section 5. City Treasurer. provides that the City Council may authorize by resolution persons other than the City Treasurer to sign checks on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appoint or employ certain named officers or employees in accordance with the Code of Ordinances of the City of Atlantis to various positions within the City government and to authorize certain individuals to sign checks on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTIS, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Atlantis in accordance with the provisions of Article III. Sections 7. through 9. of the City of Atlantis Charter, hereby appoints and/or employs the persons named below to the following offices and City positions:

Section 2: The above-named officers shall take and subscribe an oath before an officer duly qualified to administer oaths as required by law, which oath will then be filed with the City Clerk and recorded in the minutes of the City Council organizational meeting.

Section 3: The above-named Mayor and Vice Mayor shall hold office until their successors shall qualify and be appointed in accordance with the provisions of the City of Atlantis Charter. The above-named officers of the City shall hold office until their successors shall qualify and be appointed and shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council.

Section 4: In accordance with Article IV. City Officers. Section 5. City Treasurer. of the City of Atlantis Charter, the City Council does hereby grant the authority for signing checks drawn upon any depository of City funds to all members of the City Council and to Brian R. Moree, City Manager.

Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption and upon the new Officers taking the oath of office.
